- ◆ **On Thursday, 14 October, the Draft State Budget Law for 2022 was submitted to Saeima for consideration by Jānis Reirs, Minister of Finance.** In the next year's draft budget, significant funds are allocated to increase the salaries of healthcare staff, cultural workers, teachers, and people employed in the interior affairs sector. The draft budget also includes significant additional funds for state security-related measures, adherence to national commitments and decisions made, and other crucial priorities. - ◆ **On Wednesday, on 13 October, domestic GMTN Notes were offered due on 24 January, 2029.** Offered securities with the total nominal value of EUR 50 million were sold in a competitive multi-price auction. The total demand reached EUR 73.0 million. **The volume-weighted average yield rate was 0.035%.** (RĪGA, Oct 13, [Treasury](#))
